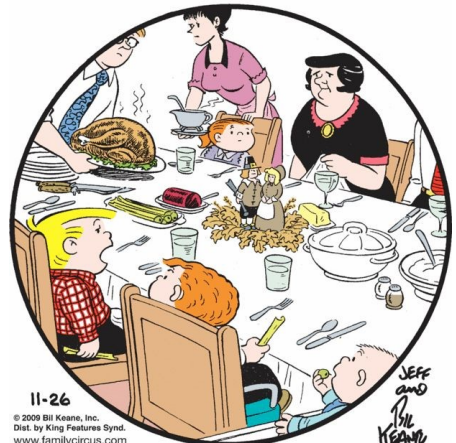

Governor Visit and Club Summit

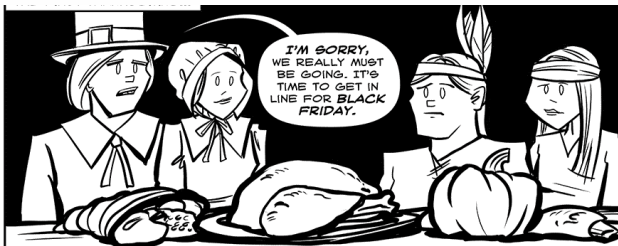
