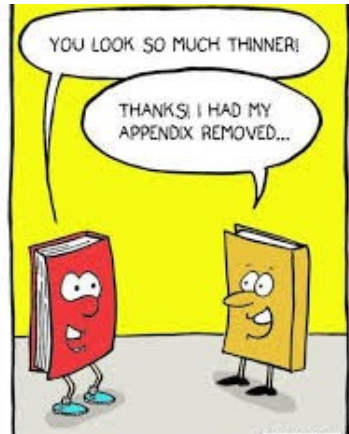

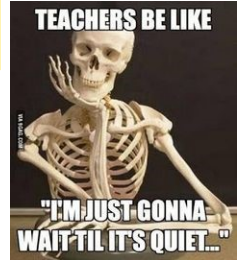


George Wilsey's "True Story" Column
