But there is little direct evidence that Spooner, who became the Warden of New College, Oxford University, ever said these things...[it] is thought that [one] slip of the tongue prompted students and perhaps fellow academics to make up, probably out of fun, other misquotes and attribute them to Spooner.

Examples are "It's roaring with pain" for "it's pouring with rain." Or "that's just a lack of pies" for "pack of lies". Happily, there are those who have a "plaster man" to overcome the problem, even if they haven't got a "master plan".

Perhaps in defense of the hapless academic, the Oxford Dictionary Of Quotations lists only one authenticated Spoonerism – though it is not the one he admits to. Discussing the impact of "the rate of wages," Spooner is quoted as saying: "The weight of rages will press hard upon the employer."
