The Kiwanis mission is to help children throughout the

world by staying true to its core values of stewardship. It was no surprise that the Kiwanis Club of Sunshine City sought to learn about the Guardian ad Litem program.

I shared GAL successes and challenges, including anecdotally, the outcomes of reunification or adoption. First was how the program actually progresses from identification of a case needing a GAL, with visits by CPI, EYA Sheriff and others at the outset, then submitted to a Judge of the 6th JD who, when agreed, issues an order for the assignment of a GAL. I always tell the I explained the excellent initial training and ongoing and mentoring prior to taking a case and the ongoing training after The Tallahassee staff, under the direction of ED Alan Abramowitz, (who is also a GAL himself), operates with a very small staff, under legislative and executive authority. The program, which saves millions of tax dollars with the VOLUNTEER base keeps us abreast of changes authored by members on both sides of the aisle. Volunteers use their own transportation and do not get travel. It is a labor of love. JDs throughout the state recruit and train some 10,000 Volunteers.

I encouraged all members to consider attending an Orientation with the assurance that there is Never any pressure to become a GAL. The effort is exceptionally rewarding but the decision is not to be taken lightly. I did ask that each one tell another person about the program and encourage attending an orientation.

It is with gratitude that I thank all Kiwanians for the help the provide children and promote goodwill and camaraderie for members and friends. God Bless Kiwanis and the GAL program. —Norm Bungard
