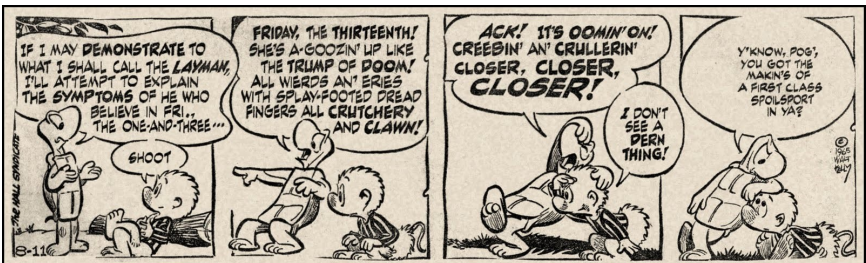

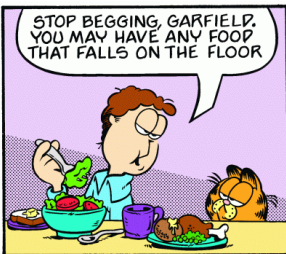
District 13 Family Picnic at Kiwanis Park

Kiwanis Park in St. Petersburg, FL, was established over 35 years ago by what was then Division 20. The members told the City of St. Petersburg they wanted to build a park, and made a financial commitment

of \$125,000.00 over five years. The Division members also supplied all the original labor, materials, and equipment. Kiwanians planned the park to be used primarily by children and included a "totlot" playground, multi-purpose courts (basketball/volleyball), picnic shelters, etc. Following Kiwanis members' five years of investment and labor, the city renamed the property "Kiwanis Park." The project was a major success. The then City Manager called it "a novel idea...original thinking". The city's Leisure Services Director said the planned park was "a great contribution to the community." Since then, generations of the city's children and their families have enjoyed the park, which they clearly associate with the efforts of Kiwanis.
