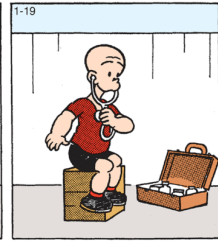
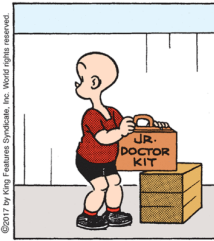
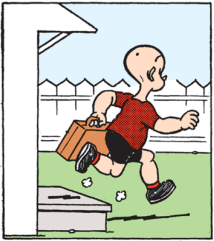
Fines

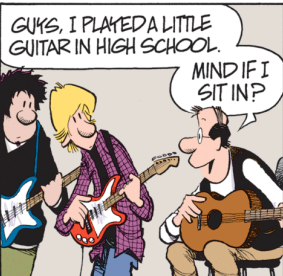
