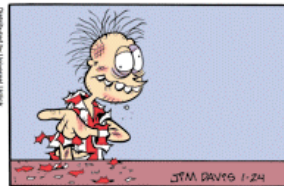
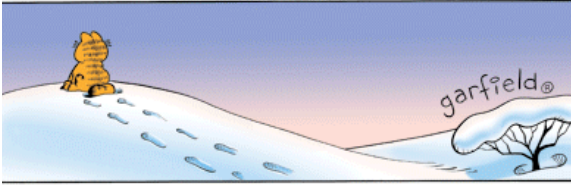

On behalf of my nation, the Philippines, thank you, Kiwanis-family members, for saving lives through The Eliminate Project.

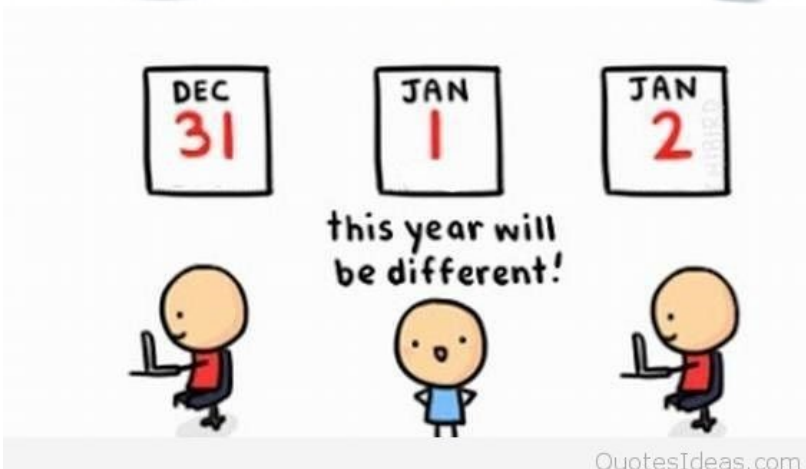
