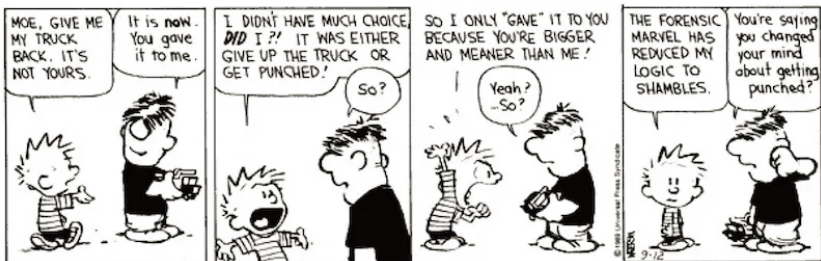
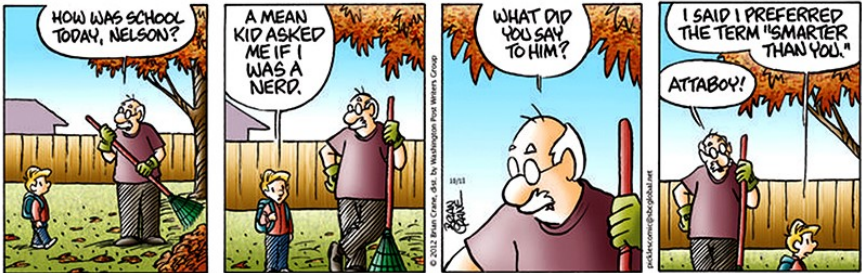


Anti-Bullying Day is observed today Friday, May 4th, 2018. It has been observed annually on May 4th since 2012.
