THE SUNSHINER November 16th Speaker Box

Speaker Information: Becky Dineen and her husband Art Howe are local Beekeepers and their company is "A Bee's Place". They have over sixty hives in three apiaries located in St. Petersburg, Pinellas Park and Seminole. They have been keeping bees for over five years and visit other Beekeepers to discover different varieties of honey they can share. Becky was formerly the Vice President of the "Pinellas County Beekeepers Association" and she currently holds a position with the State of Florida as an apiary inspector. Their company, A Bee's Place, provides honey bee removal and relocation, pollination, hive maintenance and placement services, as well as selling local and specialty honeys.

Club Presentation: Becky provided some general information about bee's: The queen copulates with the drones; she lays up to two thousand fertile eggs daily, each in a cell of the hive; the female bees (workers) collect nectar and pollen over 3-5 mile areas; when they return, the honeybees make and store honey; Fertilized eggs produce workers (sterile females), and unfertilized eggs produce drones (males). Becky spoke about how viruses can destroy a bee hive in one day; that killer bees have moved from South America to Florida and have reached as far north as Orlando; how the weather effects bees and what they do; She also answered lots of questions from our club members (e.g. killer bees are dangerous; when to gather the honey; what happens when the gueen dies; etc.) Art, Becky's husband, discussed the different bottles of honey he brought (e.g. blueberry, raspberry, pumpkin, wild flowers, etc.) and mentioned their unique tastes and colors; he explained why hives are moved around to cities, towns, farms, states, countries, etc. to pollinate the flowers, vegetables, fruit, etc. Following a few more questions, Becky and Art brought their honey bottles forward and allowed members to sample the different honeys. They also gave one of their "A Bee's Place" bottles of honey (pumpkin) and gave it to the winner of our 50x50 raffle (President Jean).
