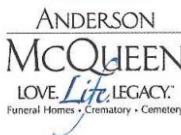

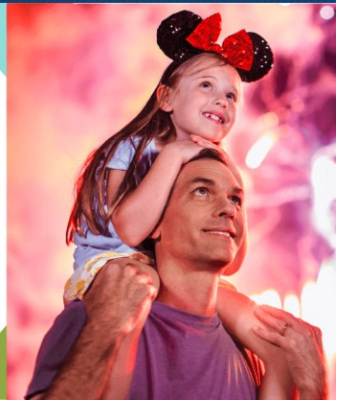

You have told us in the Bible:

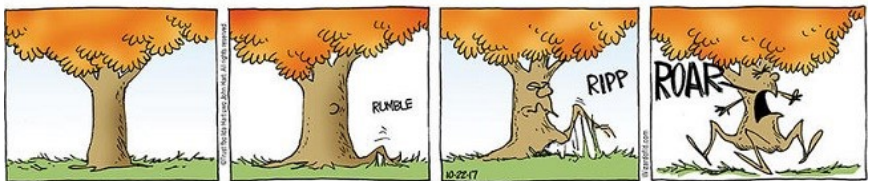
“Deep waters cannot quench love,
