Ed Lillich purchased and delivered the food to be prepared by Sunshine City. Jim Humphries purchased and delivered the necessary hardware.

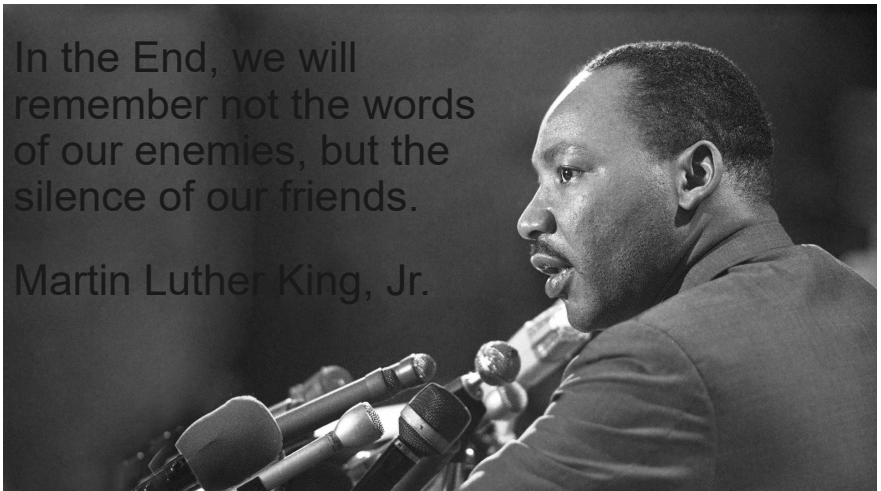
