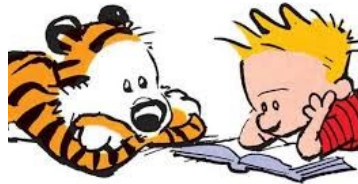
Fines

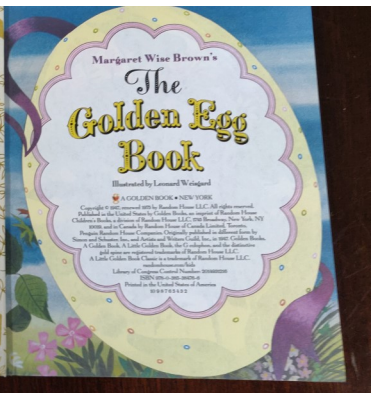
