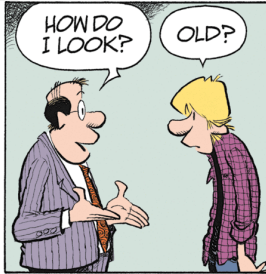

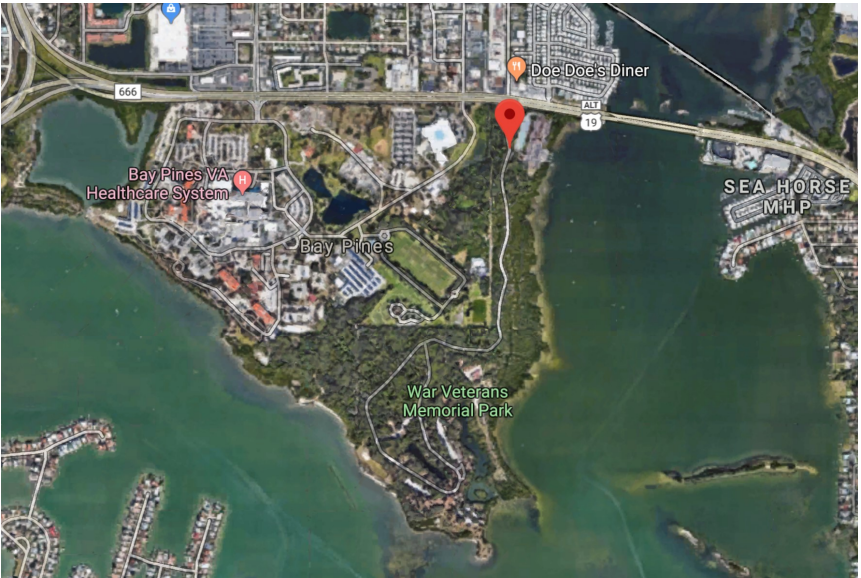
**Our Keynote Speaker: The Reverend Clarence Williams,
